Sunday 22nd October - Loxley Edge Rocks and Wharncliffe, Stocksbridge.

Visit to local exposures of quarried and natural Sandstones and Gritstones. Great examples of sedimentary features at micro and macro scale. Meet at 10:00 on Station Road, Deepcar (Just past Lowood Club). Two sites – 1st is the quarry area, a short easy walk from the road. Wharncliffe is 20 minutes' walk steadily uphill, then downhill all the way home! Come dressed for the weather; hiking boots recommended. Bring sufficient food and drink for up to 3-4 hours.
