Huddersfield Geology Group

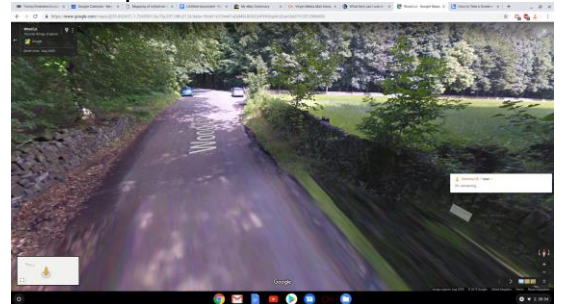
Wednesdays 22nd May - Medieval iron workings near Storthes Hall (Myers Wood) with Ian Warrington meet at 7pm

The walk is through the woods on woodland paths, down the hill to an area of the archaeological dig known as the Myers Wood bloomery. The walk down should only take 15mins. The aim will be to identify the small waste heaps against the details in the book 'The Iron Makers of Myers Wood ISBN 0905747-01-1'.

We will discuss some of the findings in the book around the Geology and methods used. Unfortunately traces of the bloomery have been covered up. .

A torch might be useful if it is overcast, boots would be the best footwear

From Huddersfield travel along Penistone Rd and then turn down towards Thunder Bridge. Go past the Woodman (<https://www.woodman-inn.com/>) then turn right up Wood Lane. About half way up Wood Lane the road widens where cars can be parked. If you reach the football club you have gone too far. Parking area illustrated!
